BTV INFECTION IN CALVES

Fertility issues or 'dummy' calves may be the first obvious signs of BTV infection in your herd

Speak to your vet if you see these signs:

- Blindness
- Circling
- Seizures
- Weakness
- Difficulty standing
- Wide-based gait
- Passive demeanour
- Head pressing
- Poor or absent suck reflex
- Stargazing


